LEARN FROM ONE OF THE OLDEST LIVING CULTURES

Australia is a nation of indigenous cultures. This is a very big country and different cultures evolved in different areas in response to their local plants, animals and landscapes. Let the Park allow you to experience the desert from an authentic Central Australian Aboriginal perspective.

EXAMPLE OF TOUR

What is it we humans need to survive? Be met by a Desert Park Guide on arrival to begin your discovery. Be involved in interactive activities that impart knowledge on belonging to and looking after the land, its plants and animals and each other

Walk from the Desert Rivers to the Sand Country learning about how to find water in the desert and different tracks and tools used by desert Aboriginal people.

In the Park's Nocturnal House learn about hunting and sign language before continuing the journey to the

Nature Theatre to be enthralled by a presentation on birds of prey and other predators of the desert. *Nature Theatre availability dependent upon arrival time of guests.*

OUR GUIDES

All of the Park's Guides are locals and the majority are full-time professional members of the Guide Team.

Four of the eight full-time positions on that Team are designated for local Aboriginal people, as are two apprentice Guide positions.

It is the aim of the Desert Park to allow local Aboriginal people to present their own culture to visitors. In the tours such as this we will use our best endeavours to ensure that one or more of our local Aboriginal Guides will take part in the tour. However unforeseen circumstances may arise and so the Park is not able to guarantee an Aboriginal Guide at all times.
